Dear Valued Customer,

Based on CCAR145 regulation and our application for renewal approval from CAAC, CAAC formally approved BII to continue to provide maintenance work for Chinese customer with our current CAAC Maintenance Organization Certificate (MOC) which expires June 30<sup>th</sup>, 2026.

The temporary approval is valid until BII received any other formal approval issued by CAAC or before the day December 31<sup>st</sup>, 2026, whichever comes earlier.

BII is allowed to release components after maintenance work is finished during this period by this Special Approval, and the working scope is limited to the Rating specified on the MOC and latest Maintenance Capability List accepted by CAAC.
